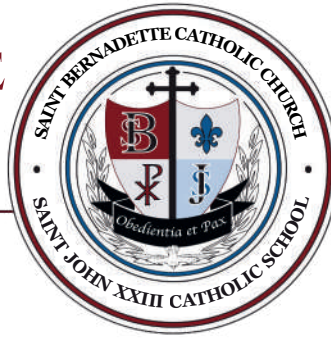

The Cross

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Jesus asks His disciples to take up their cross and follow Him. This is a strange invitation. Calling a person to follow by taking up a cross, does not seem like a strong selling point. A cross includes things like hardships, disappointments, sadnesses, heaviness, difficulties, trials, sickness, and rejection, to name a few. These are things that a person tries to avoid. Taking up a cross as a part of following Jesus seems more a reason to not follow Him. Why follow someone whose invitation includes a cross?

We all know that life has more than its fair share of burdens. Today, Our Lord is teaching us a very important lesson that every human being must learn. By inviting us to take up our own cross, Jesus calls us, in a specific way, to grow in ways that can only happen through the cross. By experiencing hard times and setbacks, a person can experience greater levels of meaning and purpose. The cross, when embraced with faith, can lead a person to holiness and a greater awareness of God. It is often in the struggles that a person hears things that otherwise would not have been heard. C.S. Lewis once wrote that “God whispers to us in our pleasures; God speaks to us in our conscience; but God shouts to us in our pain. Pain is the megaphone that God uses to rouse a deafened world.” Pain can move our heart in ways that few things can.

While it is true that good things can come from experiencing pain, this is definitely not the same as saying pain is good. Sickness, suffering, and death are not good in and of themselves, and we do well to avoid them. But when hardships must be faced, and they cannot be avoided, we are called to take them up as crosses to follow Christ. When we do that, they have the potential to deepen us and to open us to a better life.

Several years ago, I was blessed to speak with a young man dying of cancer, who told me that by God's grace, he is more alive after the diagnosis than in any other moment of his life. After he made his way through the initial shock, with God's help, he realized that he was a stronger person than he ever imagined himself to be. I met a young mother who suffered a miscarriage. As she worked through the sorrow, with God's help, she was motivated to begin a ministry to help other mothers who lose their children in similar circumstances. I've spoken with many married couples who, after their first major argument and all the hurt and pain and healing that it involved, could say that with God's help, their relationship today is deeper and more real than it was before. I met someone who lost a job. He shared with me that it was not until he was unemployed that he began to realize how valuable his family was.

There is something about the struggle that makes us stronger. Biologists have something they call “the adversity principle.” A plant, for example, without any stress, won't thrive. Instead of growing, the plant will decay and die prematurely. This notion of “no pain, no gain” applies to us as well. If life's experiences and challenges don't make you stronger, like the untested plant, you risk growing weaker. Imagine God as the “Divine Diamond Cutter” or “Divine Sculptor”. As an expert diamond cutter works on an unattractive diamond to make it something valuable and beautiful, or a great sculptor chisels away at a piece of marble to produce a masterpiece, so too, God is shaping and forming you into His masterpiece. If the diamond or marble were conscious and able to speak, it would at first howl in agony and protest its treatment—but in the end be amazed and delighted at what it had become. The crosses you carry are for your good even though they don't feel good in the moment.

Visio Divina, Explained!

Visio Divina (Latin for “divine image”) is an extension of the ancient practice of lectio divina (“divine reading”). Visio Divina is, in a sense, praying with one’s eyes, or using the medium of sacred art to assist in lifting the mind to God.

Believers have always connected with the divine through visual representations of faith. This can be seen in the frescoes that adorn the walls of historic churches, paintings on the ceiling here at St. Bernadette, or in the stained glass windows of a simple country church.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that true and beautiful sacred art evokes and glorifies the transcendent mystery of God. Its specific vocation is to draw people toward prayer, adoration, and the love of God through visible expressions of Christ, Mary, the angels, and the saints.

“Art is capable of making visible our need to go beyond what we see and it reveals our thirst for infinite beauty, for God,” said Pope Benedict in 2011. Pope Saint John Paul II described the relationship between goodness and beauty in this way, “beauty is the visible form of the good.”

In practicing Visio Divina, as with Lectio Divina, the faithful “read” (or view), reflect, respond, and rest with the image, inviting the Holy Spirit to move them accordingly.

The St. Bernadette SVdP Conference serves the poor and needy who live within our boundaries. Additionally, our Conference shares our food collections and time with St. Matthew's Parish, an inner-city Church with few resources or members to help serve the vast number of poor who live in the area.

Our Conference uses most of the funds we receive to help pay rent and utility bills for individuals and families in our area experiencing situational poverty. Most need help because of a temporary or recent hardship. Your generosity allows them to keep a roof over their heads and the electricity on until their situation improves.

Last quarter, the Conference expended nearly \$7,300 in rental assistance and \$1,300 to help neighbors with utility bills. Many Phoenix area families are only one rent payment away from eviction.

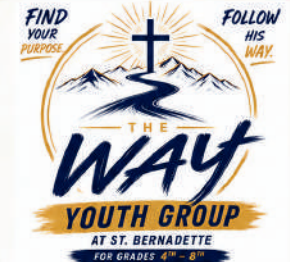
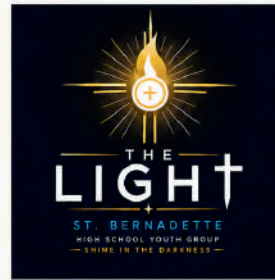

Open your home to the *Blessed Mother*

WHAT: The **Pilgrim Virgin Home Visitation** is a spiritual program in which a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a 28" replica of Our Lady of Fatima, visits the homes of parishioners. It is a travelling sacramental offered by the Legion of Mary for installation in your home to create an opportunity for families to embrace and deepen their faith thru prayer, reflection, and devotion to Mary.

WHY: The Pilgrim Virgin Mary Home Visitation is an aid to help us respond to the requests made by the Blessed Mother during her apparitions at Fatima. The essence of her requests is threefold:



- 🌹 **Return to God** - turn away from sin and obey the Ten Commandments.
- 🌹 **Pray the Rosary** - offer prayers daily for peace in our hearts, homes, and the world.
- 🌹 **Make Reparation for Sins** – undertake acts of penance and sacrifice.

HOW: To schedule the visitation, **contact Catherine Smith, President of the Legion of Mary - Our Lady of Lourdes Praesidium at (403) 580-9605**, and the statue will be brought to your residence and installed with a beautiful prayer ceremony by members of the Legion of Mary with you. The statue may remain in your home for at least two weeks. At the end of the visitation, the members of the Legion of Mary will return to pray and recite “Mary’s Farewell” with you. Then our Blessed Mother is once again ready to travel to another home of one of her children.
